

This matter came on for consideration of the Receiver's Third Motion to Approve Partial Sale and Memorandum in Support. The Court has reviewed this Motion and the Status Reports filed by the Receiver. The Court notes that the Receiver involved all parties in the process of selling these assets and that all parties to this lawsuit consent to these sales.
